Dear Chief Turner:

Please be advised that the Atlanta Citizen Review Board (ACRB) has concluded its investigation and adjudication of the complaint filed by Mr. Raymond Washington alleging that on March 28, 2015, Atlanta Police Officer David Holleman (Unique ID #5432) falsely imprisoned him when he unlawfully stopped and detained him. Mr. Washington further alleged that Officer Holleman engaged in excessive force when he pointed his firearm at him, grabbed and threw him against the patrol car and searched him.

The Board determined that the false imprisonment and excessive force allegations against Officer Holleman be assigned a finding of **Sustained** and recommends that he receives a Written Reprimand as penalty for both infractions.

It is further recommended that APD look further into the following:

1. Whether Sgt. Anthony Moore violated any APD policies pertaining to his actions as it relates to him failing to register Mr. Washington's complaint and his transporting Mr. Washington to work in an APD vehicle;
2. Whether 911 Dispatcher Jacqueline Benton violated any APD policies pertaining to her actions as it relates to providing Officers Holleman and Duncan incomplete subject demographic information when dispatching the call;
3. Whether Mr. Washington's claim that while he was waiting for a supervisor to arrive on the scene, Officer Holleman tried to get him to leave the scene.

Attached is the Investigative Summary Report. The ordinance requires that the Chief respond in writing regarding which recommendations are accepted, rejected, or will be implemented with modifications within thirty (30) days of the submission of a recommendation for action by the Board to the Chief (see Sec. 2-2211(O) of the Ordinance 07-0-0141).
