Dear Chief Shields:

Please be advised that the Atlanta Citizen Review Board (ACRB) has concluded its investigation and adjudication of the complaint filed by Gwendolyn Martin, alleging that on October 26, 2016, during a traffic stop, Atlanta Police Officer Leslie Okoka (Unique ID #4640) was rude and threatening towards her in that he snatched her driver's license from her hand, screamed at her and repeatedly threatened to issue her a citation.

The Board determined that the **Conduct allegation** against Officer Okoka be assigned a finding of **Not Sustained**.

However, the Board determined that Officer Okoka was in violation of the **Atlanta Police Department's Standard Operating Procedure pertaining to Extra Jobs, APD.SOP.2060, Section 4.1.1** and assigned a finding of **Sustained**.

The Board is aware that the APD had also conducted an investigation into this incident and came to the same conclusion as the Board on both allegations and imposed on Officer Okoka a written reprimand as penalty for violating APD.SOP.2060. The Board agrees with the department's action.

The file is available for review upon request. The ordinance requires that the Chief respond in writing regarding which recommendations are accepted, rejected, or will be implemented with modifications within thirty (30) days of the submission of a recommendation for action by the Board to the Chief (see Sec. 2-2211(O) of the Ordinance 07-0-0141).
