Dear Chief Shields:

Please be advised that the Atlanta Citizen Review Board (ACRB) has concluded its investigation and adjudication of the complaint filed by Raynard Jackson alleging that on November 1, 2016, Atlanta Police Officer Rawdon Lorde (Unique ID #6291) acted inappropriately by arresting him.

The Board determined that the **False Arrest allegation** against Officer Lorde be assigned a finding of **Not Sustained**.

The Board further determined that based on the evidence obtained during the course of the investigation that Officer Lorde's report pertaining to this incident was not complete and accurate as per APD.SOP.3060. Officer Lorde stated in his OPS statement that one of the witnesses he interviewed at the incident location told him that the victim never touched Mr. Jackson; neither this information nor the witnesses' name is reflected in his report. Thus, the Board determined that the allegation of **Violation of Department Standard Operating Procedures**, specifically APD.SOP.3060 and APD.SOP.2010, Section 4.2.21, against Officer Lorde be assigned a finding of **Sustained and recommends that Officer Lorde receives an Oral Admonishment as penalty**.

The file is available for review upon request. The ordinance requires that the Chief respond in writing regarding which recommendations are accepted, rejected, or will be implemented with modifications within thirty (30) days of the submission of a recommendation for action by the Board to the Chief (see Sec. 2-2211(O) of the Ordinance 07-0-0141).
