Please be advised that the Atlanta Citizen Review Board (ACRB) has concluded its investigation and adjudication of the complaint filed by Ron Jackson alleging that on February 2, 2017, Atlanta Police Officer Juan Restrepo (Unique ID #0728) failed to take appropriate action when he falsely arrested him and his friend Dominic Hannah for smoking marijuana in Woodruff Park. He also alleged that an officer, whom he believed was Officer Restrepo, tried to get him to lie and falsely implicate Mr. Hannah as having marijuana. Mr. Jackson further alleged that some of the items that were seized from Mr. Hannah were not put into Property.
