Dear Mr. Brogdon:

I am in receipt of the Atlanta Citizen Review Board's letter pertaining to the complaint of Ms. LaSandra Warner and Mr. Randy McClarity, recommending that the allegations of **False Imprisonment** be **Sustained** against **Officer Kristina Bogle** and **Officer Megan Norris**, as well as the finding of **Sustained** against Officer Bogle on the charge of **Excessive Force**.

At this time, the Office of Professional Standards has concluded its investigation into the allegation surrounding Ms. Warner's and Mr. McClarity's complaint. The investigation substantiated allegations against Officer Bogle concerning **APD Work Rules 4.1.1 Appropriate Action and 4.6.9 Use of Firearms**. Officer Bogle was **Sustained** on violations of both work rules and received corrective action. As noted by your investigator, Officer Norris had resigned from the Department prior to the complaint being filed, so no disciplinary action was taken against her.

As to the Board's concerns about Officer Bogle's truthfulness, the Office of Professional Standards cited. archived audio recordings of Zone 1 radio traffic do in support Officer Bogle's statement.
