Dear Chief Shields:

Please be advised that the Atlanta Citizen Review Board (ACRB) has concluded its investigation and adjudication of the complaint filed by Evanna Mills alleging that on June 10, 2017, Atlanta Police Officers Jeremiah Boyd (Unique ID #6594) and Jordan Wolford (Unique ID #5451) falsely arrested her for driving under the influence of alcohol upon their investigation of a traffic accident. Ms. Mills further alleged that Officer Wolford refused to provide his name and badge number upon her request and turned his nametag away from her view.

The Board determined that the **Appropriate Action Required** allegation against both officers be assigned a finding of **Exonerated**.

The Board further determined that the **Failure to Provide Identification** allegation against Officer Wolford be assigned a finding of **Not Sustained**.

The file is available for review upon request. The ordinance requires that the Chief respond in writing regarding which recommendations are accepted, rejected, or will be implemented with modifications within thirty (30) days of the submission of a recommendation for action by the Board to the Chief (see Sec. 2-2211(O) of the Ordinance 07-0-0141).
